On the last date of hearing following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the parties are in agreement that on making payment of an amount of Rs.4,90,000/- over and above the amount already paid to the claimants, this matter can be settled. Counsel for the claimants has signed the proposal sheet.

To us, this offer seems to be just, reasonable and equitable in the facts and circumstances of the case. Learned counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company prays for time to get concurrence from the concerned authority.

To come up on 31.10.2022

Copy of the order be supplied to the representative/counsel of the respondent-Insurance Company.”

Mr. R.N. Lohan, Advocate for the appellants was present. He signed the consent agreement, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.4,90,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Ninety Thousand Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal.

Mr. Lalit Garg, Advocate for the respondent No.3-Insurance Company has also signed the said statement today accepting the proposal made by the appellants.

Learned counsel states that agreed amount be released in favour of appellant No.1-Gudia wd/o Dulla Ram. It is further undertaken that in case in future

any claim is raised by any other appellant(s), the appellant No. 1 shall indemnify the said claimant(s).

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.4,90,000/-(Rupees Four Lakhs Ninety Thousand Only) favouring appellant No.1-Gudia wd/o Dulla Ram with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 12.12.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
