Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the aforesaid FIR has been is relating to one another criminal complaint lodged by the petitioner against the aforesaid companies. However, the present petition is relating to complaint lodged by the petitioner against respondent No.3-Apple International through MO of Apple India Pvt. Ltd. and respondent No.4-Dun and Bradstreet India Pvt. Ltd. and no FIR has been registered in the present case relating to the complaint Annexure P-1 dated 19.08.2020. The counsel for the petitioner further submits that in this manner the present petition cannot be disposed of being rendered infructuous as till date no action has been taken by the police in the complaint Annexure P-1.

ASI Gurcharan Singh submits that on the basis of the complaint

lodged by the present petitioner FIR No.136 dated 02.08.2022 has been

registered under Section 379 Cr.P.C., Section 66 (b) of IT Act, Section 51 of Copyright Act and Section 103 and 104 of Trade Marks Act against Wandoujia with parent Co. alibaba.com and UC web with parent Co. alibaba.com.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner with prayer to decide his representation Annexure P-1 dated 19.08.2020 and to take legal action against the respondent Nos. 3 and 4.

In the light of the above, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to representation No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 19.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner in accordance with law within next two months of the receipt of a copy of this order.
