The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 5 to deliver possession of land allotted in the year 1977 to the petitioner as war widow of 1971 Indo Pak Aggression.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly submits that CWP-12492-1999 had been filed by the petitioner before this Court which was allowed vide order dated 25.11.1999 by the Division Bench and the respondent - State was directed to deliver possession of the land within a period of two months and that in case the same was not possible to allot some alternative land to the petitioner.

Taking into consideration that a Division Bench order had already been passed in favour of the petitioner and a second writ petition for seeking enforcement of order already passed by a writ Court in Division Bench, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file appropriate petition for seeking compliance of the order dated 25.11.1999.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
