Prayer in this application is for preponing the date of hearing in the main case from 10.11.2022 to an early date.

In view of averments made in the application the same is allowed and the main petition is taken up for hearing today itself i.e. 28.10.2022.

**CRM-M-44245-2022**

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 113, dated 14.03.2022, under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 34 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled with the intervention of local panchayat and respectables and in that regard a copy of an affidavit dated 11.10.2022 has been produced in Court, which is taken on record.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Chetan Sharma, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State whereas, Mr. Daljeet Singh Virk, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of complainant and filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record.

The factum of compromise has not been disputed either by the counsel for the State or by the counsel for the complainant.

In view of the fact that the parties have settled the dispute amicably, this Court is of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period. Moreover, the disposal of trial will take long time.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Ordered accordingly.
