Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.140 dated 07.06.2020 under Sections 302/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 18.11.2021: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even as per the FIR the petitioner has only been named as a conspirator who, allegedly, along with his co-accused, hatched a conspiracy, pursuant to which the deceased, Sudhir, was killed; but with the

petitioner admittedly not present at the spot at the time of the occurrence, even as per the FIR; and he in fact having been declared to be innocent in a report filed under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C.

He next submits that a co-accused of the petitioner who was also similarly summoned by the trial court on an application filed under Section 319 of the Cr.P.C. before that court, has already been admitted to bail by this court vide an order passed on 14.10.2021, upon that person having filed CRM-M-43519 of 2021 before this court.

He submits that the said accused was admitted to interim bail though he was otherwise shown to be present at the spot as per the FIR...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and he is released on interim bail and is facing the trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the order dated 18.11.2021 passed by this Court, vide which interim bail was granted to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.
