The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 192 dated 03.8.2021, registered under Sections 307, 506, 120-B, 34 of the IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 24.11.2021, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Reply by way of affidavit of Manoj Gors, PPS, Sub Division, Lehra, District Sangrur, filed in Court today, on behalf of respondent-State, is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would argue that there is no allegation in the FIR that the petitioner herein is a person who opened fire upon the complainant. The only allegation is of apprehension that the petitioner herein was keeping track of the movements of the complainant. The main enmity is against one Bhagwan Singh alias Gaggi. It is submitted that the petitioner is ready to join investigation.

Adjourned to 25.05.2022.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 24.11.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Gurcharan Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 24.11.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
