This is an application for disposal of the matter as having been rendered infructuous.

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the part of the impugned order dated 25.08.2021 qua the petitioner (Annexure P-5), as well as, movement order dated 15.11.2021 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.4, vide which the petitioner has been transferred to 216 Battalion Orissa.
