The learned State counsel has submitted that earlier the petitioner was called number of times to the Police Station by giving notice under Section 41A Cr.P.C. but he did not appear and the petitioner is also involved in 5 more cases and that was the reason as to why the present FIR has been lodged. He has, however, today on instructions from ASI Bodh Raj stated that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court on 22.11.2021, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is fully co-operating with the investigation process and he is not required for custodial investigation.
