Main Case

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondent Nos.3 and 4 to pass an appropriate orders on the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-1) dated 16.09.2021 submitted under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the application moved by the petitioner under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007 (for short, the Act) is pending before respondent No.4 since September, 2021. Hence, about one year has elapsed since filing of the said application, despite the fact that the same was required to be decided within a period of 90 days as per the provisions contained in the Act. Therefore, the respondent No.4 be directed to pass the necessary order on the application moved by the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Prateek Rathee, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Even counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 4 is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the application of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to take a final decision on the application moved by the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
