The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.61 dated 4.9.2021 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station, Women Cell, Sector 17, U.T, Chandigarh.

By virtue of the order dated 26.4.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance to the order dated 26.4.2022 petitioners have joined investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for petitioners.
