AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition was filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 22, dated 18th April, 2019, under Sections 379/324/323/148/149 IPC and under Section 326 IPC added later on at Police Station Amir Khas, District Fazilka on the basis of compromise.

2. On 9th September, 2019 the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Trial Court for recording the statements with regard to genuineness of the compromise.

3. Report dated 23rd October, 2019 is received. Stating that:-

“However, respondent Baldev Singh son of Jagir Singh has not come present for recording his statement. Also neither the complainant Jasbir Singh nor injured Sukhchain Singh in their statements have submitted that they have compromised the matter with Baldev Singh. Hence, no compromise has been

effected between complainant Jasbir Singh and injured Sukhchain Singh and Baldev Singh.

4. In view of the report received, the petition is dismissed.
