This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioner has filed this writ petition being aggrieved of order dated 14.07.2021, Annexure P-19, to the extent of reversion from the post of Accountant to Auction Recorder as well as for setting aside order dated 14.12.2020, Annexure P-9 to the extent that promotion has been afforded to respondent no.4 while ignoring the petitioner's claim.

It is submitted that the petitioner, who is eligible and senior to respondent no.4, has been working continuously at the post of Accountant from 19.08.2013 to 14.07.2021 on Adhoc basis. However, he has been wrongly reverted to the post of Auction Recorder vide order dated 14.08.2021 and incorrectly ignored for promotion to the post of Accountant.

A Coordinate Bench on 06.12.2021 had directed that respondents no.2 to 4 may look into the representation submitted by the petitioner and pass a

speaking order thereon.

Learned counsel for respondents no.2 to 4 submits that the matter is under consideration and an opportunity of personal hearing was afforded to the petitioner on 21.12.2021 and a speaking order in this regard shall be passed within three weeks.

In this view of the matter, no further order is called for, at this stage, in this writ petition. Let a speaking order be passed by the competent authority on the representation submitted by the petitioner in terms of the abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for respondents no.2 to 4 before this Court, within three weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order. Needless to say, in case of an adverse order being passed against him, petitioner is at liberty to challenge the same.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
