This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to grant promotion to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.04.2019 instead of 31.10.2019 to the post of Superintendent and to grant consequential benefits to him, including promotions, seniority, arrears of salary, increments, revised retiral monetary benefits etc. with certain other prayers made in the present petition. It is further prayed that the respondents be directed to consider the case of the petitioner and take the final decision on the legal notice of the petitioner dated 20.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) by passing a well reasoned speaking order within a time bound frame.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the legal notice of the petitioner dated 20.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice of the petitioner dated 20.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of three months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
