[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/2, dated 09.09.2022 in CRWP No.8655 of 2022.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/2 reveals that CRWP No.8655 of 2022 was allowed and the petitioner granted liberty to move a representation before the respondent, who on receipt was directed to decide the same within three working days by passing a speaking and reasoned order and to communicate the same to the petitioner without any delay.

[3] Pursuant to the time obtained by the learned State counsel on 23.09.2022, the respondent has filed reply along with copy of order, Annexure R-1/T dated 16.09.2022 mentioning therein that the petitioner has already been provided with one Personal Security officer for his security, and that in the facts and circumstances of the case, he does not require more security. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for

grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order, Annexure R-1/T dated 16.09.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
