1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 23.04.2021, in CWP-8815-2021.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 23.04.2021, CWP-8815-2021, was disposed of by directing the Regional Transport Authority, Patiala, to look into and deal with the claim made in legal notice served by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and that pursuant to the filing of the instant petition, the respondent has accepted the claim of the petitioner as made in legal notice 30.12.2019, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, there is compliance with the order of this Court dated 23.04.2021, in CWP-8815-2021 though beyond the stipulated period of two months.
