HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 for conducting impartial investigation in FIR No.275 dated 01.09.2021 registered under Sections 302, 323, 324, 427, 148 and 149 of the IPC at Police Station Ajnala, Police District Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that despite the fact that a human life has been lost, no proper investigation is being conducted in the FIR so as to elicit the truth and the accused have not been arrested.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State on the basis of status report filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Ajnala, Amritsar (Rural) dated 13.01.2022 submits that main accused namely Rubal

Singh son of Charan Singh as well as Sukhdev Singh have already been arrested and with regards to the other accused, who have been nominated by the complainant, a Special Investigation Team has already been formed on 26.11.2021, which is conducting the investigation.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that he has the instructions to state that the investigation will be conducted in accordance with law without causing prejudice to any party and the same will be completed within a period of six weeks and appropriate report as required under the Code of Criminal Procedure will be submitted before the competent Court of law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, no grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition as of now and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
