SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (Oral)

Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 34 of IPC (Sections 308 and 325 IPC added later on), in case FIR No. 411, dated 22.07.2022, registered at Police Station Israna, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the order dated 23.09.2022, passed by this Court, though the petitioner had joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned counsel for the State also confirms the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation.

In view of the fact that quashing petition based upon compromise i.e. CRM-M-38025-2022 has already been allowed by an order of even date, the present petition for seeking anticipatory bail in the said FIR

No. 411 dated 22.07.2022 becomes infructuous.

In view of the same, present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
