1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 18.12.2019, passed by the learned Rent Controller, Jalandhar.

At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that possession of the demised premises has been handed over by the respondent to the petitioner in terms of order dated 18.12.2019, passed by the learned Rent Controller, Jalandhar, in case titled as Hardeep Singh vs. Surinder Mohan and that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.
