HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner has been transferred by order dated 11.09.2022 (Annexure P-1) from Fatehabad to Ambala. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is being paid a consolidated salary, maintaining himself and his family at a far off place becomes very difficult and the transfer of the petitioner to a far off place without considering the claim of the petitioner in respect of the posts, which are lying vacant at nearby places of his present place of posting, is totally arbitrary and illegal. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, the respondents are under obligation to re-transfer the petitioner keeping in view the transfer policy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the authorities concerned on 13.09.2022 (Annexure P-2), which grievance is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case,

the respondents are directed to decide the said grievance of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the grievance of the petitioner and submits that the same will be decided within a period of two weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned State counsel further submits that in case, the petitioner has not been relieved till today from the present place of posting then he will be allowed to continue at the present place of posting till the decision of the said grievance.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
