After notice of motion, the respondents have appeared. The Principal, who has passed the orders dated 18.06.2022 (Annexures P-11 and P-12) is also present in person.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that keeping in view the instructions he has from the Principal, order dated 18.06.2022 (Annexure P-11) and the consequent decision dated 18.06.2022 (Annexure P-12) be treated as withdrawn with liberty to the respondents to pass a fresh order in accordance with law.

As the order terminating the services of the petitioner has been withdrawn on the basis of technicality, though the petitioner needs to be reinstated in service but the respondents will be at liberty to pass a fresh order and any benefits for the period for which the petitioner remained out of service, would depend upon the fresh order to be passed by the respondents.

Petition stands disposed of.
