HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that they have not completed 05 years tenure at the present place of posting but still they have been transferred to another place, which is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that once the similarly situated employees, who were also posted along with the petitioners have more tenure than the petitioners at the present station, have been retained, then transferring the petitioners out of the said station is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana,

who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the petitioners raise any grievance as raised in the present petition within a period of one week by filing any representation with the respondents, the same will be decided within a period of three weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present writ petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
