1. This petition was filed seeking directions to Director General of Police, Punjab and Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana to investigate the matter with regard to illegally confinement of the petitioner by respondents No. 4 and 5 (arrayed in the petition).

2. As per the pleadings, petitioner was being pressurized by respondents No. 4 and 5 to settle the dispute with Deepak Garg.

3. Affidavit dated 17th February, 2021, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4 was filed. As per the pleadings, departmental proceedings were initiated against respondents No. 4 and 5. Respondent No. 4 was transferred and respondent No. 5 was suspended and on conclusion of the inquiry further necessary action would be taken.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that the dispute between the petitioner and Deepak Garg no longer exists.

5. As the departmental action has been initiated against the erring police officials, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the

petitioner to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievances, if any.
