Prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.17 dated 27.01.2022, under Sections 376(2)(n), 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is behind bars since 29.01.2022. However, learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that in all, there are 13 prosecution witnesses, out of which, 11 witnesses already stand examined and the next date before the trial Court for recording the rest of the prosecution witnesses is 21.10.2022.

After hearing counsel for the parties, it is apparent that the trial in this case is virtually at the fag end. In view of the same, this Court do not find it appropriate to consider regular bail of the petitioner. However, in view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial. Disposed of.
