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In view of the oral agreed statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as learned counsel for the Insurance Company, both the parties have compromised for a sum of Rs.2,35,000/-(Rupees two lakh thirty five thousand only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, to be paid to the appellants as full and final settlement of their claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque/draft in the sum of Rs.2,35,000/- (Rupees two lakh thirty five thousand only) favouring appellant no.1 with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks from today.

The enhanced amount shall be shared by the appellants in equal share. In case of non-compliance, the appellant shall be entitled to interest @ 9% per annum from the date of order till the date of realization. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the learned counsel on record.

Appeal stands disposed of.
