This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr. P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No. 4.

Petitioner namely Daljit Kaur @ Dilraj Kaur and respondent No. 4 namely Manpreet Singh, have appeared in person and have placed on record photocopies of their Aadhar Cards as document of their identity.

Petitioner in person submits that the dispute with respondent No.4 has been amicably settled and she does not want to proceed with the present petition. Despite efforts to contact her counsel, through whom present petition had been instituted, she has not put in appearance in Court today.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Narinder Kaur, submits that there were five complaints submitted by the petitioner with the police in SAS Nagar, Mohali, and after the inquiries, the same have been filed as no substance was found therein.

In view of the categorical submission of the petitioner for withdrawal of the present petition, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
