In the present writ petition, the challenge is to order dated 22.08.2019 (Annexure P/11) passed by the respondents by which, the petitioners were transferred, on the ground that the petitioners have not completed 05 years of service at one station, which is a necessary condition for transfer.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners are already continuing at their respective station, keeping in view the interim order passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court but, now the petitioners have completed 05 years of service and, therefore, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed off as such.

Learned State counsel further undertakes that the respondent-State will not give effect to the impugned order dated 22.08.2019

(Annexure P/11) and will consider the petitioners for transfers as per the

eligibility condition of the transfer policy for effecting general transfers for the session 2022-23.

The present writ petition stands disposed off in above terms.
