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Power of Attorneys on behalf of proforma respondent Nos.4 and 5 have been filed today by Mr.Vikas Gulia, Advocate, which are taken on the record.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel for proforma respondent Nos.4 and 5 and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹6,50,000/- (₹ Six Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant and learned counsel for proforma respondent Nos.4 and 5, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant - Priyanka daughter of Sh.Vijender Singh.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹6,50,000/- in the name of the appellant - Priyanka daughter of Sh.Vijender Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 21.09.2022, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of

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the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
