Instant petition was filed seeking a mandamus directing the official respondents No. 1 to 6 for removal of a *dharna/obstruction* staged by the private respondents against opening of a liquor sub-vend at Village Sirthala, Tehsil Payal, District Ludhiana.

Case projected on behalf of the petitioner was that the private respondents are not letting the petitioner to operate the sub-vend in spite of the fact that there is no violation of the excise policy.

During the course of hearing today, counsel for the petitioner would submit that the *dharna/obstruction* has since been removed and he has instructions not to press the instant petition.

In the light of such statement made, at the Bar, instant writ petition is disposed of as not pressed.
