The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to get the sale deed for the plot of the petitioner registered as the same has not been done since the allotment of the plot on 20.06.2018 and to decide the representation dated 05.04.2021 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
