This writ petition in the nature of Habeas Corpus was filed to locate the detenue-Nisha Sharma.

From the pleadings, it is forthcoming that the petitioner solemnized marriage on 11.08.2021 with the detenue against wishes of the parents. Notice of motion was issued in this case on 21.9.2022.

Today, learned State Counsel has produced the statement of detenue recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. before Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridabad.

As per the statement, the petitioner was allured the detenue to marry him by showing his false status and now she does not want to stay with the petitioner.

In view of the statement produced, there is no case of illegal detention.

The petition is dismissed.

Needless to say that the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievance, if any.
