AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed for directions to respondents No. 2 to 5 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners and also directing the respondents No. 6 to 8 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners and further directing the respondents No. 2 to 5 not to allow the respondents No. 6 to 8 to interfere with the liberty and lives of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is no threat perception and the petitioners no longer want to live in Safe House.

Learned State Counsel on instructions submits that statements of respondents No. 6 and 7 have been recorded wherein they have stated that they have no objection to the marriage solemnized by the petitioners. He further submits that the petitioners were kept in a Safe House at SAS Nagar (Mohali).

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, no further directions are called for.

Petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Since the petitioners do not want any protection, they may be permitted to leave the Safe House after complying with the due formalities.
