RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (Oral)

This petition relates to the validity of the admission granted to petitioner in BDS course for the session 2016-2017 without being required to go through the entrance examination in terms of the directions issued by the Medical Council of India on 18.09.2015.

Learned counsel for the parties conjointly state that the petitioner has already completed his BDS course and is doing internship at this stage. In the circumstances, they submit that leaving the question of law involved in the petition open, the petition may be disposed of on account of the fact that nothing material survives for adjudication in the same.

In view of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the petition stands disposed of in terms thereof, leaving all legal issues open to be raised by the petitioner in appropriate proceedings.
