1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-2, dated 02.05.2019, in CRM-M-18880-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/2 reveals that CRM-M-18880-2019, was disposed of by directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rural, Amritsar, to take a decision on representation dated 17.02.2019 and in case any action was required in respect thereto, to take suitable action as deemed necessary in accordance with law.

3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the learned State counsel having sought time to obtain instructions, representation filed by the petitioner has been decided and offence under Section 307 of IPC, has been added in the FIR against the accused on the complaint of the

in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
