The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.84 dated 03.08.2022, under Sections, 61, 1, 14 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
