In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the services which the petitioner had rendered with the HSMITC from the year 1981 to 2002, has not been taken into account as qualifying service for computing his pensionary benefits by the respondents, which action of the respondents, according to the petitioner, is contrary to the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in **State of Haryana vs. Deepak Sood and others** decided on **15.07.2008** as well as against the Instructions dated 07.01.2002 issued by the Government of Haryana. Prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to grant the petitioner benefit of the said service for all intent and purposes.

From the pleadings, it transpires that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P/4) upon them, which is still pending consideration with the respondents hence, the interest of justice

will be served in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his representation, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P/4) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed off.
