In view of the oral agreed statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as learned counsel for the Insurance Company, both the parties have compromised for a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lac Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, to be paid to appellants as full & final settlement of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque/draft in the sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lac Only) in favour of appellant No.1- Jagpreet Kaur Wd/o Resham Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from the receipt of the copy of this order. The said amount shall be shared equally by the appellants. In case, appellant No.2 is minor, her share be deposited in a nationalized bank in the form of FDR to be realized on her attaining the age of majority.

In case the amount is not deposited within the prescribed period, the appellants shall be entitled to interest @

9% per annum on their share from the date of order till the date of realization.

The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel for the appellants as a receipt on record.

Appeal stands disposed of.
