On 30.09.2022 following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the appellants has made a statement which
is taken on record, stating that towards full and final settlement of
all claims raised by the appellant, an amount of Rs.4,00,000/- be
paid to him.

To us, this offer seems to be just, reasonable and
equitable in the facts and circumstances of the case. Learned
counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company prays for time to
get concurrence from the concerned authority.

To come up on 20.10.2022.

Copy of the order be supplied to the
representative/counsel of the respondent-Insurance Company.”

Mr. Sanjay Panghal, Advocate for the appellant was present. He signed
the consent agreement, showing willingness to accept an amount of Rs.4,00,000/-
(Rupees Four Lakhs Only) towards full and final settlement of the claim in the
present appeal.

Mr. Nigam Bhardwaj, Advocate for respondent No.3-Insurance
Company has also signed the said statement today accepting the proposal made by
the learned counsel for the appellants.

Learned counsel for the appellants states that the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellants as per MACT award.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed cheques in the sum of Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs only) in the respective names of all the appellants in the same proportion as awarded by MACT with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 20.01.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
