This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents to grant protection of life and liberty to the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to consider and decide the representation dated 17.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner seeking protection for his life and liberty along with his family members.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and conveying the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
