1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 25.05.2022 in CWP-22435-2018.

2. At the outset, learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of speaking order dated 28.09.2022, passed by the respondent. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of claim of the petitioner having been accepted in part, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 29.08.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law, to the extent the same is adverse to the interest of the petitioner.

3. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner, as prayed for.
