Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been transferred without following the provisions of the transfer policy as the preferences given by the petitioners have not taken into consideration while transferring them and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that it is a matter of fact that there are vacant stations near the present place of posting of the petitioners where the petitioners could have been easily adjusted but the said benefit has not been given to them and the petitioners, who are Guest Lecturers and are working on a fixed salary, have been transferred to a far off places which will result in financial hardship for them as well.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance vide representations

which have been appended with the petition from Annexures P-7 to P-10, which are still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that representations of the petitioners Annexures P-7 to P-10 will be decided within a period of two weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case, the petitioners have not been relieved from the present place of posting, they will be allowed to continue at the present place of posting till the decision of the representations.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
