The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 8, as they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members.

A perusal of the file shows that the petitioners have filed a representation dated 20.09.2022 (Annexure P-4) before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar i.e. respondent No.2 to consider and take appropriate action on the same.

As per averments made in the petition, both the petitioners are major. The year of birth of petitioner No.1 is 2000 and date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 25.10.1996. Copies of Aadhar cards of both the petitioners are appended with the petition as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively. They got married on 19.09.2022 as per Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-3.

In view of the prayer made by the petitioners and without going into the merits of the claim raised by the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- the Commissioner of

Police, Jalandhar to look into the representation dated 20.09.2022 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same expeditiously and also take appropriate action to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, in accordance with law.
