As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representative of respondent No.4 - Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.3,50,000/- (Rupees Three Lac Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is allowed to the appellant in full & final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with the direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.3,50,000/- in the name of the appellant with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/office shall issue a proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned Counsel,/representative of the respondent No.4 - Insurance Company. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
