[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 06.07.2022 in CWP No.14042 of 2022 in which interim order was granted in the same terms as in CWP No.11922 of 2021 in case titled as Roshan Lal vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to issuance of notice in the instant petition, the respondents have complied with order, Annexure P/1 and released wheat stock to the petitioner as per entitlement under the Public Distribution System for distribution to the ration card holders, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
