The learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the services of the petitioner has been de-regularized by the respondents vide impugned order dated 15.3.2018 (Annexure P-7) only on the ground that the petitioner did not file any reply to show cause notice and have not given any explanation in his defence. Learned counsel submits that the services of the petitioner were rightly regularized by the respondents vide order dated 30.11.2012 (Annexure P-3). Learned counsel further submits that the operation of the impugned order was stayed by a co-ordinate Bench while issuing notice of motion and the petitioner is still in service as a regular employee and in case, the petitioner is given liberty, the petitioner will approach the respondents raising his claim for maintaining the initial order of regularization which was passed in favour of the petitioner.

The learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is received from the petitioner with regard to the fact that the petitioner was entitled for the regularization of his services as per 2003 policy, the same will be looked into and appropriate order will be passed and till the same is passed, the interim order passed by this Court will be allowed to continue.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents raising the grievance.

Ordered accordingly.
