This is claimant's appeal seeking modification of award passed by MACT, Yamuna Nagar.

On request, the instant matter is taken up in National Lok Adalat, accordingly discussed.

Consent form has been received which is duly signed by Mr. Namit Khurana and Mr. Abhinav Kalia, Advocates for the appellant. The same is taken on record.

As per the said consent form and statements of learned counsel and representatives of the respondent – Insurance Company, a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rs. Three Lakhs only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant.

Accordingly, we dispose off this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.3,00,000/- in the name of the appellant with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent–Insurance Company. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the
