Main case

The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing impugned certificates dated 21.10.2021 and 22.10.2021 (Annexures P4 and P5, respectively) illegally declaring the petitioner medically unfit being over-weight.

Pursuant to previous order dated 07.12.2021, the respondents have conducted medical re-examination of the petitioner through the Review Medical Examination Board. The report to that effect has been placed on record, wherein, it has been stated that on re-examination, the petitioner has been found medically fit in all respects.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for enrollment/appointment, as per his merit.
