Keeping in view the fact that out of the total 08 witnesses, only 01 witness has been examined and the petitioner is behind the bars for the last one year and seven months, the present petition is disposed off with the direction to the trial Court to make all the efforts to conclude the trial within a period of 06 months from the next date of hearing even if, the same is

done by giving short adjournments.
