As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company, counsel for respondent No.2 (associated in the process of settlement since the recovery rights has been given to the Insurance Company to recover the amount from respondent No. 2 in accordance with law) and counsel for the appellant, (separately recorded today), a sum of Rs 95,000/- (Rupees Ninety five thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant the enhanced amount would be paid to the appellant. In backdrop of the settlement between the parties, the respondents has not opposed the application for the condonation of the delay in filing of the petition and as such application is allowed and the delay stands condoned.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.95,000/- (Rupees Ninety five thousand only) in the name of the appellant (subject to recovery rights) with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 06.05.2022 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. After deposit of amount, the Insurance company shall be at liberty to recover the same from respondent N.2 as has been directed by learned MACT. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
