The writ petition filed by the petitioners is not only bereft of particulars but they are trying to raise an absolutely obsolete claim. The land was acquired in the year 1909 i.e. more than 113 years before the filing of the writ petition. The petitioners claim that the respondents should be directed to determine the compensation in terms of Section 24 (1)(a) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

In view of the huge delay and latches, the writ petition is dismissed with costs of Rs.50,000/-which shall be deposited within a period of 3 months with the 'Poor Patients Welfare Fund' of the Post-graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh, personally or through its website "www.pgimer.edu.in" and produce the receipt duly verified by his counsel before the Registrar General of this Court.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
