Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 490 dated 31.10.2019, registered under Sections 406, 409, 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Badshahpur, District Gurugram.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 24.02.2022 of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Crime-II, Gurugram, already filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Vide order dated 23.11.2021 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 23.11.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP Dharambir, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.11.2021 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
